SCHOLARSHIPS 2013

Alphington Grammar School is offering two types of academic scholarships for 2013.

1. Scholarships for students who display General Academic Excellence. Scholarships are available for students entering each of the following years in 2013: Year 5, Year 7 and Year 10.
2. Scholarships for students who display Academic Excellence in the Modern Greek language (spoken and written). Scholarships are available for students entering each of the following years in 2013: Year 7 and Year 10.

Application forms and other information are available from the school office. Alternatively you can apply online at www.alphington.vic.edu.au.

General Academic Excellence

The General Academic scholarships are externally managed by ACER (Australian Council for Educational Research), with the exception of those for Year 5 entry, which are managed by the school.

The deadlines for scholarship applications are strict and ACER will charge late fees for all late applications. The deadline for all scholarship applications (Years 5, 7 and 10) to reach Alphington Grammar School or to be lodged online is **Friday 9 March 2012**.

There is a Basic Registration Fee of \$60 (Year 5) or \$95 (Years 7 and 10) that must be included with the application to be valid. Late applications incur an additional Late Registration Fee.

Scholarship selection for Year 5 entry is based on an interview and confidential references. For Years 7 and 10 entry it is based on competitive examination and an interview.

Following the release of examination results, candidates who have performed exceptionally well will be invited for interview. Scholarships will be awarded following the interviews to suitable candidates.

Academic Excellence: Modern Greek

The internally managed Greek Excellence scholarship will be awarded to students who display academic excellence with particular reference to the Modern Greek language

(spoken and written). This will be determined by written test and interview. There is a \$60 administration fee, which must be paid when lodging the application. The school must receive the application by **Friday 9 March 2012** to be valid.

All Scholarships

Scholarship tests will take place on **Saturday 17 March 2012** at Alphington Grammar School.

Candidates who are shortlisted for interview will be notified after the examination and offers of scholarships and results will be made available by the end of Term 2 2012.

The number, duration and value of all scholarships may vary at the discretion of the school. Decisions on these matters will be guided by the school's evaluation of each successful candidate.
