Terms of Payment

The payment of one tuition fee instalment in advance applies to all students. This fee is payable in October of the preceding year. As a consequence of this advance tuition fee payment being made, no fee billing is made in the October of the student's final year.

Tuition Fee Discounts

Sibling Discount: The sibling discount for tuition fees is calculated at a rate of 5% for the second child and 30% for the third and subsequent children attending the School.

Full Fee Payment in Advance Discount: A 5% discount of the annual Tuition Fee will be applied to families who pay their full school fees in advance with the October Payment.

Consolidated Fee

The Consolidated Fee (**compulsory charge**) is applied to each year level. This fee is levied to cover the cost of compulsory camps, excursions and incursions, sport fees, Inter-House and Inter-School competitions, subject competitions, Athletics membership, art supplies, provision of classroom texts, photocopying, the supply of printed materials, Student ID Cards, School Magazine and Student Accident Insurance Protection.

Consolidated Fee exclusions

Fees relating to Music and Ski Camp (optional), text books and stationery (Booklist), private music tuition, VAPA concert charges, Gateways Program and overseas trips are not included in the consolidated fees and are billed accordingly.

Information Communication Technology Levy (ICT)

The ICT Levy covers the provision of hardware, Internet connection and software to ensure that all students have access to computers in the school.

Building Levy (compulsory charge)

The funds received through the Building Levy (**non- tax deductible**) assist the School's ongoing capital development and improvement programs.

Building Fund Donation (tax-deductible)

The Building Fund Donation of \$750 per annum, per family is a **voluntary tax-deductible gift** to the School. The Alphington Grammar School Building Fund is endorsed by the Australian Taxation Office under subdivision 30-BA of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997 as a deductible gift recipient for the operation of such a building fund.

Late Fees

A late fee may be charged for each account not be paid by the due date.
